

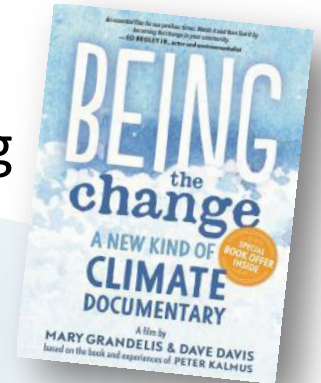

From Mary Grandelis and Dave Davis



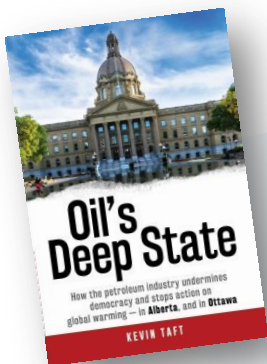
